

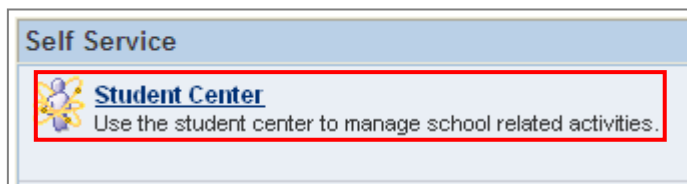


Academic Requirements Report Overview


The Academic Requirement Reports allows you to view a summary of your progress towards completing your academic program. The report evaluates coursework to determine whether courses on the student's record meet the graduation requirements of the declared academic plan/sub-plan (major/minor/specialization).

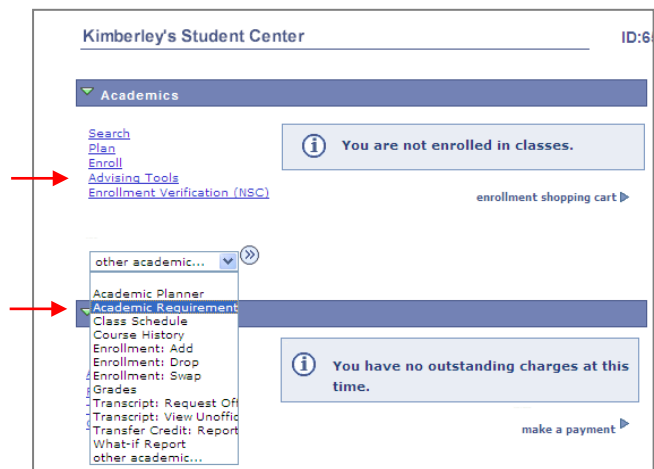
How to Access the Academic Requirements Report

1. Sign in to PAWS and navigate to the Student Center, by selecting the [Student Center](#) link.



2. There are two ways to access the report:

- **Via the Academics drop-down menu:** Select 'Academic Requirements' from the drop-down menu and click the  icon to access the report.



- **Via Advising Tools:** Click on the [Advising Tools](#) link. On the resulting page, click on the Academic Requirements: [View my advisement report](#) link to access the report.

3. On the resulting page, you will see your Academic Requirements Report.

4. A green arrow pointing downward  notes that a requirement is **NOT** satisfied.

A green arrow pointing to the right  notes that a requirement **IS** satisfied.
